Greetings!

Please be informed that the school is organizing an 'Educational tour to the Dragon country – Bhutan' from 27<sup>th</sup> February to 5<sup>th</sup> March 2019 for the students of Class XI. Students will be taken to Kaharbandi Gumpa of Phuntsoling, Buddha Point (Kuensel Phodrang), King's Memorial Chorten and National Library of Thimphu, Drukgyel Dzong, Taktsang Monastery, Kyichu Lhakhang of Paro among many others.

Details of the tour may be read as under:

- Tour cost per child: Rs.29, 000/- (Rupees Twenty Nine Thousand only)
- Accommodation shall be on three-sharing basis and the tour programme is subject to minimum confirmation of 25 students.
- Due to limited availability of seats selection of students will be on first come first serve basis.
- Separate male and female escort teachers will be deputed by the school.
