Day	Explanation
1	<p>The class will begin with a brief discussion on plants - their types, importance, parts, along with a diagrammatic explanation of how a seed germinates into a plant. This will be followed by a detailed study of various types of plants, including - trees, shrubs, herbs, climbers and creepers.</p> <p><u>Activity 1</u> Students will be asked to draw a plant and label its parts.(to be done in EVS notebook)</p>
2	<p>A brief discussion on the importance of plants in our lives and the various plant products will be done.</p> <p><u>Activity 2</u> Prepare a poster with a caption on the importance of plants and why we must save them.(to be done in EVS notebook)</p>
3	<p>Students will be asked questions to test their knowledge about animals - their types, their homes ,products that are received from them etc.This will be followed by a detailed discussion on types of animals (domestic and wild).Students will also be encouraged to talk about their pets (if any).</p>

4	<p>A brief discussion on birds and insects will be done. Teacher will discuss about the babies of the animals and the various food items that we get from animals as well as the other animal products.</p>

They also give us oxygen to breathe.</p> <p>b) Three natural shelters (examples) are : i) tree - Monkeys live on trees. ii) cave-Bears live in caves. iii)den –Lions live in dens.</p> <p>c) We get milk, egg, meat, wool, silk, honey, etc from animals.</p>

Lesson -12

1. We see different kinds of plants and animals around us.
2. We are dependent on them for number of things.
3. A plant has different parts like, roots, stem, leaves, flowers, buds etc.
4. Plants provide us with oxygen and many other useful things.
5. Plants are of different sizes and forms. The different types of plants are trees, shrubs, herbs, climbers and creepers.
6. Animals are of two types-domestic animals and wild animals.
7. Wild animals live in forests, grasslands etc.
8. Animals give us milk, eggs, meat, wool, honey and silk.
9. Domestic animals live in shelters made by humans.
10. We must protect plants and animals.

2. We celebrate functions, festivals, birthdays, weddings, anniversaries etc.

3. Festivals are of two types- Religious festivals and National festivals.
4. Independence Day, Republic Day and Gandhi Jayanti are our national festivals.
5. 15th August is celebrated as Indian Independence Day.
6. India became free and independent in the year 1947.
7. On 15th August, the Prime Minister of our country hoists the National Flag at the Red Fort in Delhi.
8. 26th January is celebrated as our Republic Day.
9. On 26th January 1950, India became a Republic and adopted a constitution.
 - On 26th January, our National Flag is hoisted at all public places, offices and schools. A parade is held in Delhi at Rajpath where the President of our country takes the salute.
 - 2nd October is celebrated as Gandhi Jayanti as its the birthday of M.K Gandhi (Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi).
 - Diwali, the festivals of lights celebrates the return of Lord Rama to Ayodhya.
 - Dussehra is the festival to celebrate the victory of good over evil.
 - In Dussehra, huge effigies of Ravana, Kumbhakarana and Meghnada are burnt.
 - Eid is a Muslim festival that marks the end of the holy month of Ramzan/Ramadan.
 - Birth of Sikh gurus is celebrated as Gurburab. Prayers are offered at Gurudwaras, kirtan is sung and langar is served to all.
 - Christmas is celebrated on 25th December as the birthday of Jesus Christ.
 - Few Indian festivals includes- Holi (festival of colours), Durga Puja, Janmashtami (birthday of Lord Krishna), Pongal (harvest festival of Tamil Nadu), RakshaBandhan, Teej, etc.

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
