

ANNUAL REPORT OF CHILD PROTECTION COMMITTEE, 2021-22

- 1. Child Protection Committee of DPS Guwahati was constituted during the session 2019-20 and deal with cases related to child sexual abuse. The committee remains available to all parents and children as per the provisions of POCSO Act 2012. POCSO Act 2012 was formulated in order to effectively address sexual abuse and sexual exploitation of children through legal provisions. The school website has also been provided with a link where information on the procedures of CPC regarding safety rules and school policies has been elaborated.
- 2. The policies of Child Protection Committee of DPS Guwahati apply to teaching and non-teaching staff and other ancillary staff working in the school. Sessions were conducted for transport, security and housekeeping staff from 15 December 21 to 18 December 21 by Ms Manjuri Bharali, school counsellor, to make them aware about the stance of the organization regarding Protection of Children from Sexual Offences.
- 3. To create awareness for prevention and reporting child sexual abuse cases, a Sensitisation Drive on Child Protection Policies was organised by CPC for the students of DPSG. The sessions were conducted in both online and offline mode by Ms Leena Borah, special educator and counsellor and Ms Manjuri Bharali, school counsellor.
 - Sensitisation sessions for the students of classes III to V were conducted from 22 November 21 to 27 November 21 and for classes IX and X on 8 January 2022.
